JUNE SCHEDULE:



CAL.....Crochet Along.....Every Tuesday 1-4

We will be making the Bandito Cowl. This uses 1 skein of worsted weight yarn, and size I hook. Come once to get started, or come every week to sit & crochet.



KAL.....Knit Along.....Every Wednesday, 1-4

We will be making the Patriotic Shawlette. This uses 3 colors of DK weight yarn & sizes 7, 9, & 11 circ. needles. Come once to get started, or come every week to sit & knit.

Of course the sample shown is not finished or blocked 😊



Every Friday this month.....Sock Knitters Unite!.....1-4

Let's gather and help each other through those difficult sections, sharing knowledge and getting encouragement.

(If you're not working on socks, come join us anyhow!)



Sat, June 8.....Pioneer Gloves.....1-4

You need 1 skein of fingering weight yarn & size 2 DPNs. Pattern available all month long.



Sat, June 15.....Spatterdash Wrist Warmers.....1-4

You need 1 skein fingering weight yarn and size 1 needles, a size 1 circ (40"), plus 28 buttons (10 mm). Pattern available all month long.



Sat, June 22.....Lazy Rib Fingerless Mitts.....1-4

You need 1 skein DK weight yarn & size 6 DPNs. Pattern available all month long.



Sat, June 29...Hot Chocolate Mittens...1-4

You need 1 skein bulky yarn and size 8 DPNs. Pattern available all month long.



Thurs, June 27.....Spinning Group.....11-3

Welcoming all spinners -past, present & future. Come see a demo of this lost art, and meet some nice people!

Chemo Caps.....All Fall & Winter

Knit or crochet a warm chemo cap to be donated locally to The Hope Center for Cancer Care on 46 in Howland. We have patterns. Any yarn purchased for a cap gets 20% off.

Knitted Knockers.....All Fall & Winter

Knit or crochet a prosthetic for women who have had breast surgery. We send them to the national warehouse. Patterns are here. Any yarn purchased for a KK gets 20% off.

Knitting 101.....By Appointment.....\$20

Learn to cast on, knit, purl, bind off and how to hide your ends. Materials needed: worsted weight yarn, size 7 needles, scissors and a darning needle.

Crochet 101.....By Appointment.....\$20

Learn to chain, single crochet, double crochet and how to hide your ends. Materials needed: worsted weight yarn, size H hook, scissors and a darning needle.
